- 5. Parents may volunteer in their child's class. Opportunities to participate in the classroom activities can be arranged by contacting the teacher directly.

We, as parents will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- 1. Make every effort to get my child to school on time every day.
- 2. Make sure that homework is completed and materials for the next day are ready.
- 3. Notify the teacher when my child is having difficulty.
- 4. Participate in activities related to my child's education. (Examples: Back to School Night, Workshops)
- 5. Promote positive use of my child's extracurricular time.
